## CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017 MAIPO ALTO - CHILE

2017 production of 50 barrels (1.250 cases)

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### TASTING NOTES

**Colour:** ruby red.

**Nose:** Plums and ripe blueberries, graphite notes and herbal hints. .

**Palate:** Soft palate with structured tannins and a subtle influence of fine oak..

**VARIETAL** 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

**VINEYARD** Buin, Alto Maipo, Chile.

### WINE MAKING

**Vineyard:** 25 years. The vineyards grow on a terrace on the banks of the Maipo river. 100% hand picked harvest. There is a manual selection of grapes in the vineyard and then at the cellar.

**Cellar:** Cold pre fermentative maceration, 5 days. The alcoholic fermentation is carried in small stainless steel tanks.

The malolactic fermentation is made in French barrels. The wine ages during 12 to 16 months in second use barrels, in order to make a fruiter and livelier wine.

**Bottling date:** July 2018

**Market launch:** March 2019
